

First Story Golf Scramble Rules & Regs



SKILLS CONTESTS ARE LOCATED ON THE FOLLOWING HOLES:

Longest Drive: Hole #18 (women) & Hole #9 (men)

Closest to the Pin: Hole #3
Longest Putt: Hole #18
Straightest Drive: Hole #5

Dry Heave Qualifier: Hole #3
Diageo Shot Challenge: Hole #14

FORMAT: Four person scramble tournament.

RULES:

- 1. In a scramble, each player on the team tees off on each hole. The best of the tee shots is selected and all players play their second shots from that spot. The better of the second shots is determined, and then all play their third shots from that spot, and so on until the ball is holed.
- 2. After selecting a player's shot from which to play, players may place their ball within one club-length of where the ball originally lay without improving the condition of the lie (i.e. a ball that lies in the rough cannot be moved to the fairway, from a bunker to the rough, etc.). The other team members pick up their balls and place them within one club length (no closer to the hole) of the marked spot.
- 3. If the ball you choose to play is in a hazard (sand, water, etc.), the rough, or out of bounds, you cannot drop the ball outside of the hazard or rough even if relief is within one club length away.
- 4. On the green, putts need to be made within 6 inches of the marked spot (no closer to the hole). The first ball to go in the hole is counted for the team score.
- 5. Each player's tee shot must be used at least two times during the 18-hole competition.
- 6. Men tee off from the tan tees and women from the red tees.
- 7. Threesomes are permitted to rotate a fourth shot from each ball location. In other words, one person will be hitting twice from each position.
- 8. In the event of a 5 person team. Only 4 are allowed to tee off and play the hole. Members must rotate with one person sitting out each hole.
