HOUSING GRANT UPDATE

*O*ur second Housing Grant home, located in our Longview community outside of Spokane, WA, has been completed. We were able to offer a new home, which under normal circumstances would cost an estimated \$1,100 per month to purchase, for approximately \$373 per month. Furthermore, the commonly painstaking loan process was avoided.

In coordination with the Spokane Housing Authority, SUELLEN RUPP was chosen as our recipient. Suellen, a single mother of 4 children and 4 step-children, is a worthy candidate that epitomizes the successful intention and execution of this important program. Our third home, located in Umatilla, OR, has recently been completed and the candidacy process is currently underway. This gorgeous 3 bedroom, 2 1/2 bath, and 2-car garage home overlooks the Columbia River, and is sure to please our next deserving candidate.

ALBANY, REDMOND, ROSEBURG, PASCO and MOSES LAKE.
